

GLACLP Member Recognition Award

Overview

The Great Lakes Association of Child Life Professionals (GLACLP) would like to honor leaders and students that are doing great things both inside and outside of our organization in an effort to expand our profession and the field of child life.

Eligibility & Criteria

Any GLACLP member in good standing who demonstrates leadership and outstanding contributions to the field of child life is eligible for this award. Recipient should be involved, make a positive impact or difference for their team and patient, exhibit family-centered care when working with patients, and make a continual commitment on various committees.

Three members will be honored as the recipients of this award.

1. *Student*: A student should have completed a minimum of 2 years of school and/or completed their child life internship as required by the Association of Child Life Professionals (ACLP).
2. *New Professional*: A new professional should be employed for at least 1 full year working as a CCLS.
3. *Seasoned Professional*: A seasoned professional should be employed for at least 4 full years working as a CCLS.

Nomination Process

Any GLACLP member can nominate a qualified GLACLP member for this award.

Nominations may be submitted by the member themselves or another member of GLACLP. If nominee is being nominated by someone other than themselves, endorser must have permission from nominee.

Endorser must submit a picture of the nominee with this application. The endorser should request the nominee provide them a picture so that the nominee is okay with the picture being submitted for use shall the nominee be selected as the winner.

Endorser should complete the [nomination form](#). Endorser should then submit a picture via email to childlife.glaclp@gmail.com with the subject “2021 GLACLP Member Recognition Award – nominee name”. The nomination form and picture must both be submitted by 11:59pm EST on August 29, 2021.

Selection Process

Following the final submission deadline, all completed applications will be reviewed and a member from each of the three categories will be selected as the award recipient. The recipients and all applicants will be notified on or before September 22, 2021.

Award Presentation Process

The three award recipients will be announced during the GLACLP annual conference on Saturday, October 9, 2021. A picture of the winner will be displayed on the presentation screen during the award



ceremony. During an in-person conference, if the winner is present, they will also be asked to come forward to receive their award and be recognized. During a virtual conference, or if the winner is not able to be present at the in-person conference, the winner will receive their certificate via mail.

Each recipient will be spotlighted in our monthly member newsletter, on our social media pages, and on our website. The information for the spotlight will be gathered from the nomination and endorser forms. We will also include a picture of each recipient which would have been submitted with each application.
