 - 40 hours per week
 - 9:30am - 6:00pm M-F; weekend and holiday rotation

 - 18 bed unit
 - 40 hours per week

PRE-INTERNSHIP EXPERIENCE: PRACTICUM

Our practicum program is a minimum of 156 hours of observational experience in pediatric healthcare setting under the supervision of a Certified Child Life Specialist. You will be assigned 2–3 rotations, with a dedicated preceptor for each rotation.



INTERNSHIP

Our 640 internship will give you experience observing and collaborating with child life specialists to provide procedural, educational, emotional, and recreational support to patients and their families in 2–3 rotations.

We require that you submit the ACLP common application, as well as a supplemental KSA form. Additionally, we require that a university affiliation is established following an offer to secure a placement.
